Registered as a Public Charitable Trust in 1994, over the years, we have expanded our area of work through various innovative programmes, covering 13 cities across India by the year 2013.

Udayan Care believes that a loving home and family is the right of every child. **Udayan Ghars**, long term residential homes, nurture children, who are orphaned or abandoned, through a strategy called

LIFE - Living In Family Environment

Children are cared for by a group of Mentor Parents, socially committed individuals, who voluntarily bring up the children like their own, assisted by professional care givers and social workers. Our Mental Health experts help children overcome past traumas.

Quality Education



Each **Udayan Ghar** is home to 12 children, as a unit, with separate *Ghars* for boys and girls. Located in middle class neighbourhoods, the *Ghars* help children reintegrate with mainstream society. All children are also ensured quality education. Those above 18 are looked after in our Aftercare, to pursue higher education and transition to independent living.

Hope

Starting in 1996, with 3 children in one home in Delhi, Udayan Ghars have now spread to other parts of India with plans to set up more *Ghars* and reach out to more children in the coming years.

Empowerment

USF is a unique initiative that works towards higher education for girls ensuring that no girl, with the drive to learn, is denied her dream of educating herself, due to lack of support. The Fellowship selects girls in Class X from government schools through a unique process called NAT: which assesses the girls'

Need, Ambition and Talent

The girls are supported for five to six years, till graduation or technical training.

Achievement

USF includes both financial and mentoring support which transforms the young girls to educated, confident, socially responsible, dignified women or *Shalinis*.

Self Reliance

Starting in 2002, with 72 girls in Delhi, USF has impacted thousand of girls, with some even studying in prestigious institutes like the IITs, IIMs and Cambridge. Alumnae *Shalinis* are doing well in professional streams like chartered accountancy, computer software, banking, medicine and engineering while also coming forward as mentors, donors and trainers for their fellow *Shalinis*.

Opportunities

Udayan Care Information Technology & Vocational Training Centres

aim to improve livelihood options for youth and women from underprivileged communities.

Courses are heavily subsidised and include Microsoft certified CTSP (Community Technology Skills Programme) and other advanced computer courses, spoken English, tailoring, sewing and embroidery, beauty therapy and personal grooming.

Students are also trained in life skills, given career counselling and placement assistance. Training staff also undergo capacity building to keep abreast of new technologies.

Ruhi – a young teenager and her younger siblings **Ruchi and Deepak**, lost their ailing mother and their father was not able to take care of them single handedly. Having lost the support of their family and unable to continue their education, the children felt a deep sense of loss. It was in this condition that they came to Udayan Care in 2000.

The warmth, love and consistent efforts of their Mentor Parents, care givers and social workers helped the three children cope with their traumatic past and relearn trust in people. The periodic counselling by our Mental Health experts, gradually helped them build a hopeful life.

With exhaustive home tutoring followed by education in the best schools and opportunities for self development, Ruhi, Ruchi and Deepak discovered their great learning abilities.

Ruhi completed college with flying colours, fulfilling her dream of working in a travel agency. Today she has a family of her own. She continues to find joy in her passion - chocolate making!

Ruchi, with her determination and hard work, graduated from a reputed institute in Hospitality and Management and got a job with a 5 star hotel chain.

Deepak commenced his B.A. LLB and aspires to be a lawyer.

Determination

Paromita was selected for the Udayan Shalini Fellowships, when she was on the verge of giving up her dream of completing her Physics degree. Having lost her father suddenly, her widowed mother could barely afford educating the children.

Today Paromita is pursuing a Ph.D in Physics from Kolkata's Jadavpur University and is also working as an Assistant Professor in the same University.

Anil was a disappointed youth , who had lost all hope. Unable to find a good job and being the eldest son of a farmer family, with two younger siblings, making ends meet was a struggle.

After completing the Advance Diploma in Computer Application at Udayan Care's IT&VT Centre in Haryana, he got his first job through the Centre's placement assistance. Today, an Accountant, Anil earns a 5 figure salary!

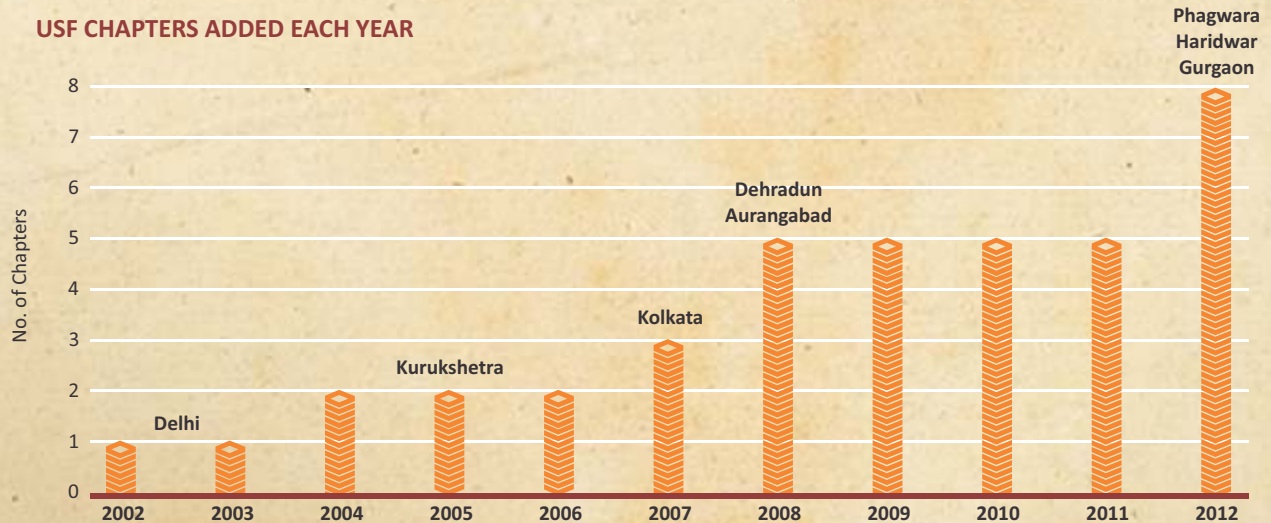


UDAYAN SHALINI FELLOWSHIPS

NUMBER OF SHALINIS IN EACH YEAR

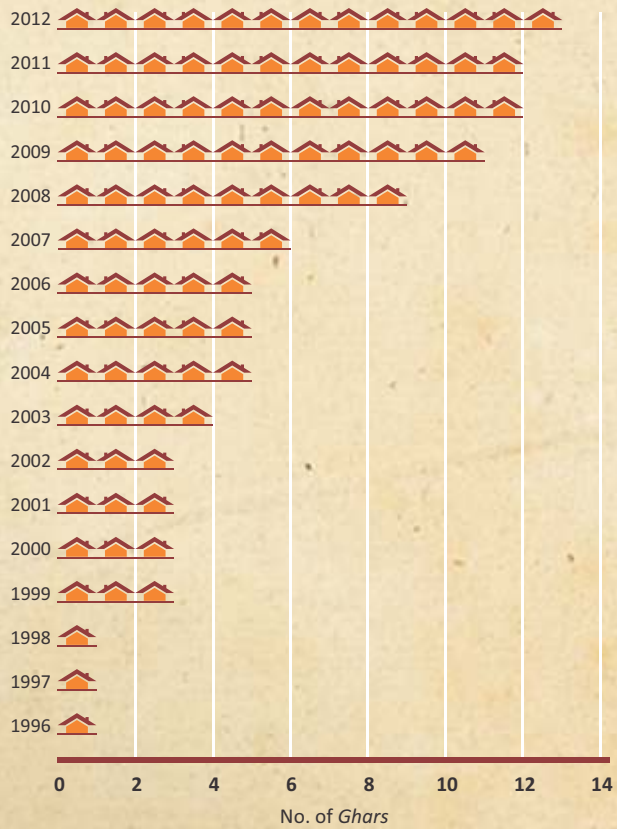


USF CHAPTERS ADDED EACH YEAR

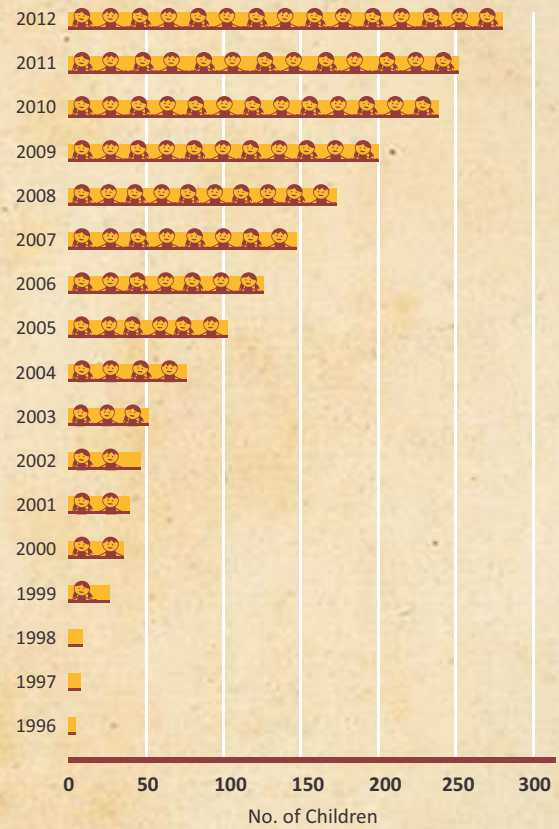


UDAYAN GHAR PROGRAMME

NUMBER OF GHARS

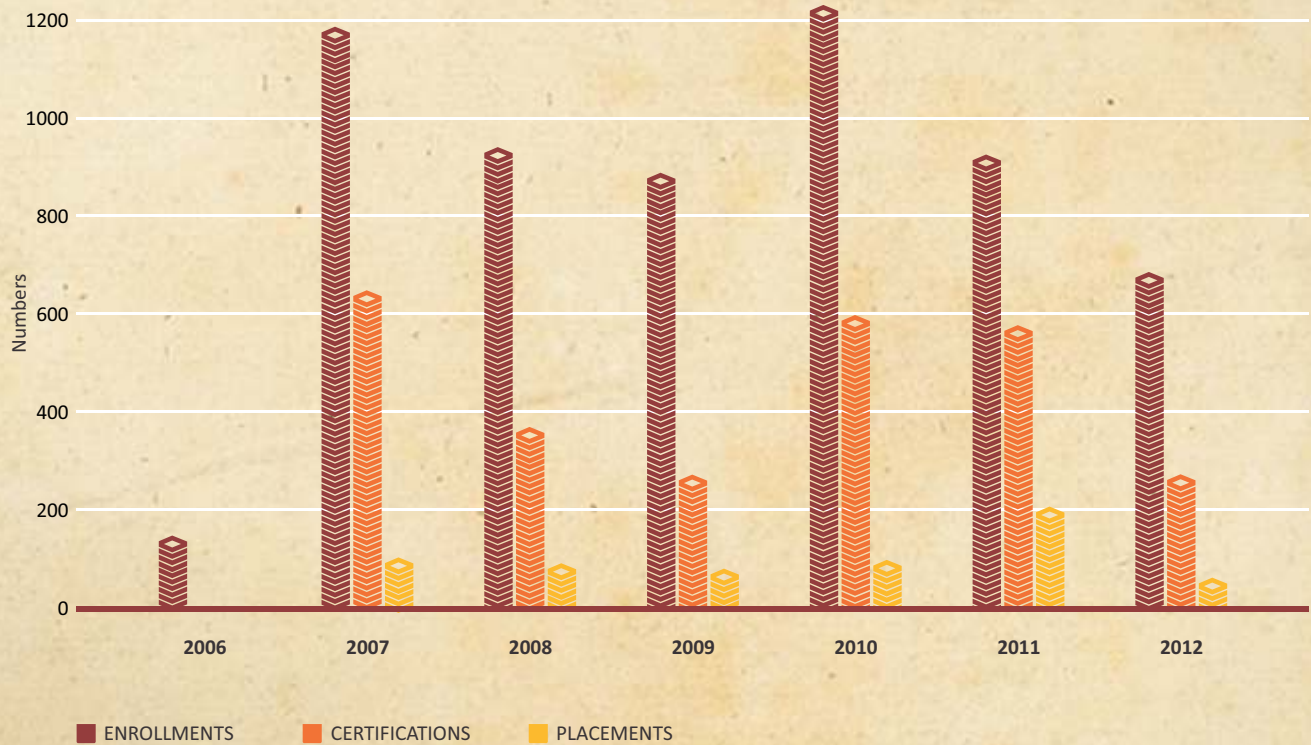


NUMBER OF CHILDREN IMPACTED
