Family Strengthening Strategies at 5th Leadership Dialogue

On September 25, 2024, Ms. Leena Prasad addressed over 100 participants at the 5th Leadership Dialogue hosted by Miracle Foundation India. As a panellist, she discussed the FiT families strengthening project in Delhi, highlighting strategies and outcomes since 2021. She stressed the importance of resources for vulnerable families to prevent institutional care and shared insights on the vulnerability mapping initiative for the Madhya Pradesh government.

Workshop on Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness | Jaipur

On August 11, 2024, the Jaipur chapter of the Udayan Shalini Fellowship held a Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness workshop for all Shalinis. The session covered essential topics like breast cancer prevention, self-examinations, and strategies to combat both cancers, including the role of vaccines for cervical cancer. The Shalinis actively engaged by asking insightful questions, making the session informative and empowering. This workshop equipped them with vital knowledge about health and self-care, encouraging them to take charge of their well-being.



5th Campus Placement Drive Empowers Youth with New Job Opportunities

On September 1, 2024, Udayan Care's IT Program hosted its 5th Campus Placement Drive in Govindpuri, South Delhi, connecting over 280 youth with job opportunities. Participants from 11 IT Centres, including 70 beneficiaries from Udayan Care's Aftercare and Shalini Fellowship Programs, attended alongside NGOs like Saathi Centre and Shanti Sahyog. Thirteen recruiters from seven companies, including Cogent E-Services and Velocity Xcelerator, conducted interviews and typing tests. The drive resulted in 164 candidates shortlisted for jobs and 80 progressing to second-round interviews, paving the way for their financial independence.

Empowering Future Chartered Accountants through Project Horizon

Deloitte has launched Project Horizon, providing financial assistance and mentorship to empower our Shalinis to become Chartered Accountants. Recently, 30 Shalinis from Chennai, Delhi, Bengaluru, Greater Noida, Gurugram, Noida, and West Mumbai participated in an insightful session emphasising skill enhancement through career-focused workshops and personalised mentorship.



This initiative plays a vital role in guiding them toward their professional ambitions.



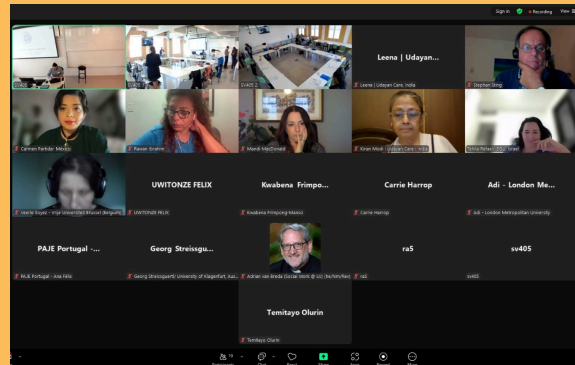
Sukriti Showcases Handcrafted Creations at BNI Netnix Event
