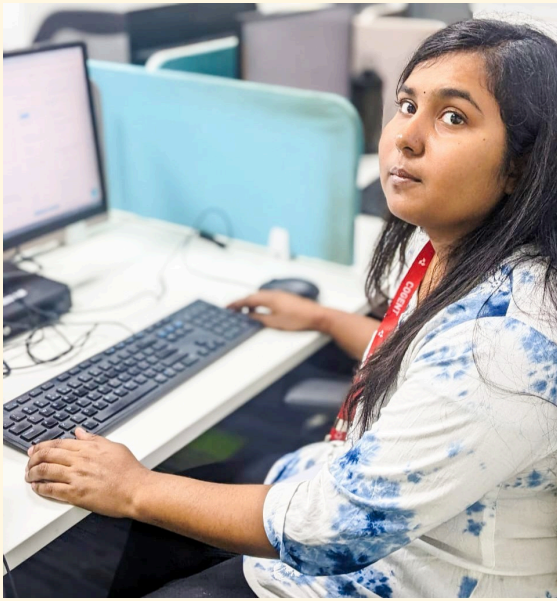
Muskan's Journey: From Determination to Leadership
